Topics to be covered:

- Update on office based anesthesia: Technical advancements such as modern infusion pumps and anesthesia agents such as remifentanyl and ketamine can markedly enhance your office anesthetic technique. Advancements in the management of nausea, fluid and electrolyte balance and other perioperative management strategies will be covered as well.
- Prevention and management of pediatric and medical anesthetic emergencies: Recent studies have demonstrated that emergency preparedness protocols tend to be largely geared to the adult patient population with inadequate attention paid to the pediatric population. We will explore the essential considerations in preventing and managing pediatric medical and anesthetic emergencies.
- Organization of the office emergency preparedness program: Each of the elements of emergency preparedness will be reviewed including organization of staff, emergency drugs, equipment and effective drills utilizing medical emergency simulation techniques.
- Closed-claims review of medical and anesthetic emergencies: Actual emergencies will be utilized to emphasize prevention strategies to assure that similar catastrophes do not take place in your office.

Biography

Richard C. Robert, DDS, MS

Dr. Robert received his BS in Applied Biology from Georgia Institute of Technology and his DDS from Emory University in Atlanta Georgia. He conducted bone graft research at the Letterman Army Institute of Research and completed his oral and maxillofacial surgery training at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor. He is currently in private practice and is Clinical Professor in the Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery in the residency program at the University of California Medical Center in San Francisco. He directs the office anesthesia curriculum and co-directs the curriculum in surgical anatomy. He has been active in hospital affairs and has chaired the section of oral surgery and dentistry at Mt. Zion Hospital in San Francisco and Seton Medical Center in Daly City, California.



Dr. Robert has also been active in the various committees and councils of CALAOMS and AAOMS and he lectures widely for these organizations.
